Octreotide Shortage

It has come to our attention that there is a national shortage of Octreotide, the agent on formulary for the S1316 MBO study. Per S1316 protocol, it is appropriate to use the depot form or any other metastat analog; see Section 7.3 for a complete list. It does not have to be Octreotide.
