

S2505 Kickoff: Non-Inferiority of Short-Course RT for Soft-Tissue Sarcoma

S2505: Phase III Randomized Study Testing Non-Inferiority of Short-Course Ultra-Hypofractionated Radiation (UHRT-5) Versus Standard Fractionation (RT-25) for Stage II-III B, Extremity, Resectable Soft Tissue Sarcoma

S2505 is the first randomized head-to-head study comparing standard to hypofractionated radiation in this setting.

Primary endpoint: non-inferior local tumor recurrence at 2 years

Shorter radiotherapy before surgery could reduce patients' time to surgery, lower costs, and enhance quality of life.

The kickoff will offer information and practical guidance on

- key trial components • eligibility criteria • treatment flow
- submission of radiation treatment plans and real-time quality assurance
 - how to complete required training on tumor contouring
 - optional biospecimen banking

S2505 activated earlier this summer and has an enrollment goal of 296 patients.
