
SOURCE DOCUMENT PORTAL (SDP)

SDP Updates (I)

- General Updates:
 - Improved performance
 - Added Help Topics drop down for each SDP screen
 - Resolved instances where site staff was unable to upload documents on SDP using direct link from Rave

SDP Updates (2)


- Source Document Portal Screen:
 - Added Document History icon which includes details about document upload, triage, who viewed the document, and date viewed
 - Added document Status column



SDP Updates (3)

- Expected Documents Screen:
 - Added Document History icon
 - Added query icon for rejected documents
 - Added Expected Date column
 - Added Uploaded? column to indicate whether or not document is uploaded
 - Added Action column which displays
 - Blue icon to display data points to be reviewed using this document
 - Green icon to upload documents
 - Documents identified as not expected by the Lead Protocol Organization can be viewed by clicking on the Documents Not Expected link

CTEP-AERS INTEGRATION

Data Flow: Rave to CTEP-AERS (I)

- Sites enter Adverse Event (AE) data in Rave and submit to CTEP-AERS rules engine for expedited reporting evaluation
- All AE data in Rave will be pushed to CTEP-AERS unless an AE has an open query
- CTEP-AERS returns a report recommendation to Rave (CREATE or NONE)
- A direct link is available in Rave to automatically log into CTEP-AERS if a report is recommended

Data Flow: Rave to CTEP-AERS (2)

- In CTEP-AERS, the AE data that is pushed from Rave will be viewable but not modifiable
 - Modifications to AE data will be made in Rave since it is the data source
 - Any data modified in Rave will require the rules evaluation to be run again
 - This will cause the updated data to be pushed into CTEP-AERS
 - AE Start Date and End Date/Ongoing are required in Rave for specific protocols
 - CTEP guidance for recording Adverse Event Start and End Dates in Rave is available on CTSU.org

Rave Reminders

- AE data should be entered in Rave and sent for Rules Evaluation (RE) at the time the AE is known/reported
- If the recommendation from the RE is to report, then click the direct link in Rave to access CTEP-AERS to complete the expedited reporting
 - A warning will appear when first logging into CTEP-AERS if the report was initiated in CTEP-AERS prior to reporting and RE in Rave
- AE data should be updated in Rave, not in CTEP-AERS
 - Data entered in Rave will be passed to CTEP-AERS and will only be editable in Rave
 - A field that is entered first in CTEP-AERS and then later in Rave could result in reconciliation issues as data in CTEP-AERS cannot synchronize with Rave once the expedited report has been submitted to NCI
- If entering a verbatim term in Rave, do not use special characters (e.g., &)

Site Notifications (Late RE Call)

- Anytime a modification is made to the AE form (insert, modify, delete) a query will be opened on the Expedited Reporting Evaluation form (Send all AEs to rules evaluation)
- If the query on the Expedited Reporting Evaluation form remains open for longer than 24 hours, an email notification is sent to the person who last modified the AE form
- The email notification states that the AEs were automatically sent to rules evaluation by the system and asks the recipient to review the recommendation on the Expedited Reporting Evaluation form

Site Notifications (Late Report Initialization)


- Anytime a recommendation to CREATE a report is generated and displayed on the Expedited Reporting Evaluation form, the site staff must initialize the report in CTEP-AERS in a timely manner
 - If the Investigator feels the recommendation is not warranted per the Protocol, override the recommendation by updating CREATE to NONE in Rave and do not initialize the report in CTEP-AERS
- If the report is not initialized, and the Investigator has not overridden the recommendation, an email notification is sent to the person who last modified the AE form
- The email notification states that there is a recommendation to report but no expedited report has been initialized in CTEP-AERS


Home Tab (1)


- The Home page subtabs have been redesigned and moved to the center of the page

The CTSU Twitter feed has been added






The Quick Links tab has been removed

Study Champion information appears in the Protocols>Home subtabs





- Will eventually replace help icons on all webpages








