SWOG Latin America Initiative

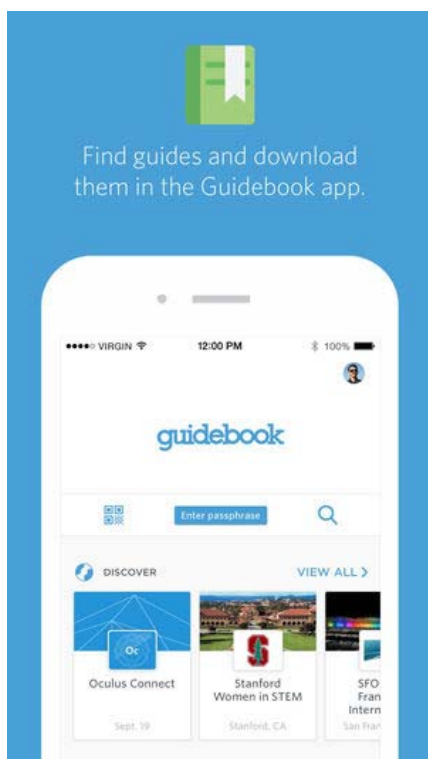
- 10 year anniversary
