





A few things to note (also highlighted in above form):

- Measurable lesions (per RECIST criteria) that are listed at baseline will remain measurable lesions, even if they eventually disappear.
- Lesion size must be report in cm.
- Assessment type used at baseline must meet eligibility requirements and be repeated at each follow-up scan.

## Baseline Tumor Assessment (BTA) form: Non-Target Disease Assessment

A few things to note (also highlighted in above form):

- Lesion size is NOT required if non-measurable "box" is checked.
- "Extent" is a free text entry field. An entry as simple as 'present' is acceptable.
- Assessment type used at baseline must meet eligibility requirements and be repeated at each follow-up scan.
